



# Do You Know Someone Who Is At Risk For A Heroin/Opioid Overdose? This Life Can Be Saved

## FREE Narcan® Kits (naloxone)

Training is open to anyone who is at risk of an opioid overdose or their family and friends. All eligible participants will receive a FREE Narcan® (naloxone) kit and a treatment voucher for 30 days of free substance abuse treatment to use or distribute to any person that needs medication-assisted treatment. In addition, education will be provided on how to administer Narcan® (naloxone) to reverse a heroin/opioid overdose. Trainings will be limited to 25 participants on a "first-come, first-served" basis.

## FREE Trainings and Education

- Addiction education and treatment options
- Signs and symptoms of overdose
- How to administer Narcan®/naloxone
- Overdose prevention techniques
- Rescue breathing
- Self-help, family support & other resources

Training will be provided by credentialed counselors and licensed nurses. Participants will have "hands on" practice of rescue breathing and naloxone administration.
